#### STEAM Learning from Around the World



Hura Delegation Visits IWA

On Friday, IWA was one of the host sites in Cleveland for the Hura Delegation, leaders visiting from Israel, who seek to learn more about



STEM/STEAM approaches. These leaders come from various cultural and religious backgrounds, yet have the same goal which is to improve Israel's ability to compete in a globalized high-tech world by supporting the children who are often "left behind" or "forgotten," so that they are able to thrive in a competitive marketplace as they mature. While in Cleveland, this group seeks to experience STEM best practices in Pre-K through employment so that they can increase collaboration and redesign/update the STEM Ecosystem in their homeland.

The Hura Delegation visiting IWA included educators, STEM teachers, religious leaders,

municipal leaders, and community youth leaders. Sponsoring this learning was the Jewish Federation of Cleveland and TIES (Teaching Institute for Excellence in STEM).

The visit included observations of classroom learning, community conversations, and a Q&A with our teacher and student panel. A special thank you to our 4th grade students who presented our guests with student-made key chains that spelled "Hura" in binary code.

#### Crochet Creations Underway

Students in grades 6-8 are offered enrichment courses during the 2nd and 3rd quarters. These courses are teacher and student interest-driven and developed, cross-curricular, can be problem-based, and include an opportunity for the students to develop soft skills such as public speaking, team-building, problem-solving skills, leadership, and communication.

This year we are offering a new course, Crochet Creations, which was initiated and is led by eighth grade students Ariana D. and Peyton N. after expressing an interest to share their talents with others. Before offering the course, they surveyed the preparatory students to determine if this something they would be interested in learning. After gathering positive feedback, they met and worked to develop weekly lesson plans, determined materials that would be needed, and started a Google Classroom to organize student learning.
