### **Upcycled Carnival and Museum**

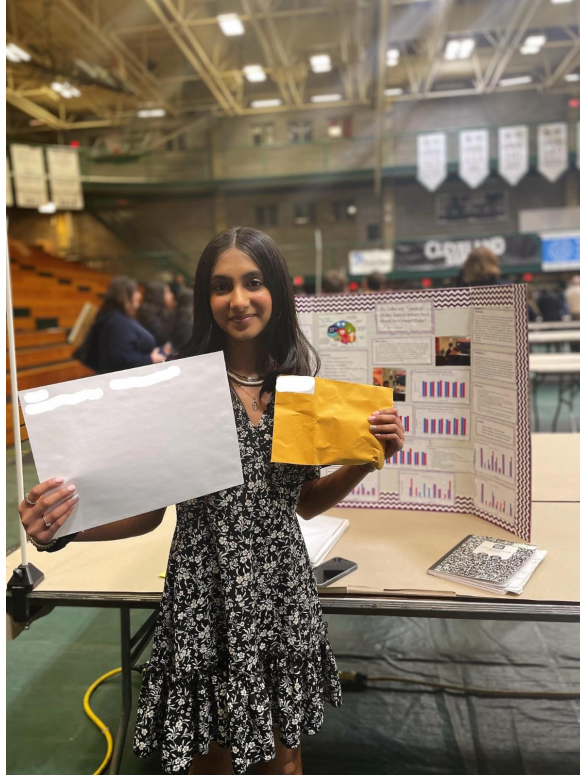




The second grade students put their inquiry skills to the test as they explored stewardship through various lenses in a deeper dive of understanding sustainable living. Merging entrepreneurial, STEM, and WARRIOR mindsets, students became engaged at the onset as they experienced the Question Formulation Technique. This was followed up with an interactive discussion led by Upcycle Parts Shop via which the second graders learned about social enterprise. Prompted by Mrs. Rolle and Mrs. Delbane, students were tasked with creating something new from something old as a way to rethink the ideas of reuse and recycle. Students designed and added value to “throw-away” materials with their upcycled products and works of art. In a parallel mission to Upcycle Parts Shop, the students wanted to promote community and they chose to have a dual purpose showcase: a museum and a carnival! This permitted the students to truly share their passion and encourage others to imagine what can be as we rethink what we discard. Thank you to the Y.E.I. 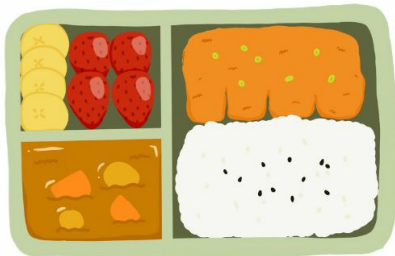
