




Cross Country: Boys & Girls, Grades 1 - 8



Grades 4 & 5 will run a 1.5 mile race on Sundays and Grades 6 - 8 will run a 2.0 mile race on Sundays. Grades 4 - 8 will race at the same site.

Practices will be three weeknights per week from late July to

early October (M, T, Th -or- M,W, Th). Time of practice is 6 to 7:15 or 7:30 p.m. and locations vary between Wallace Lake, Bonnie Park, South Quarry Lane, Big Creek Parkway, and the West Creek Reserve.
