

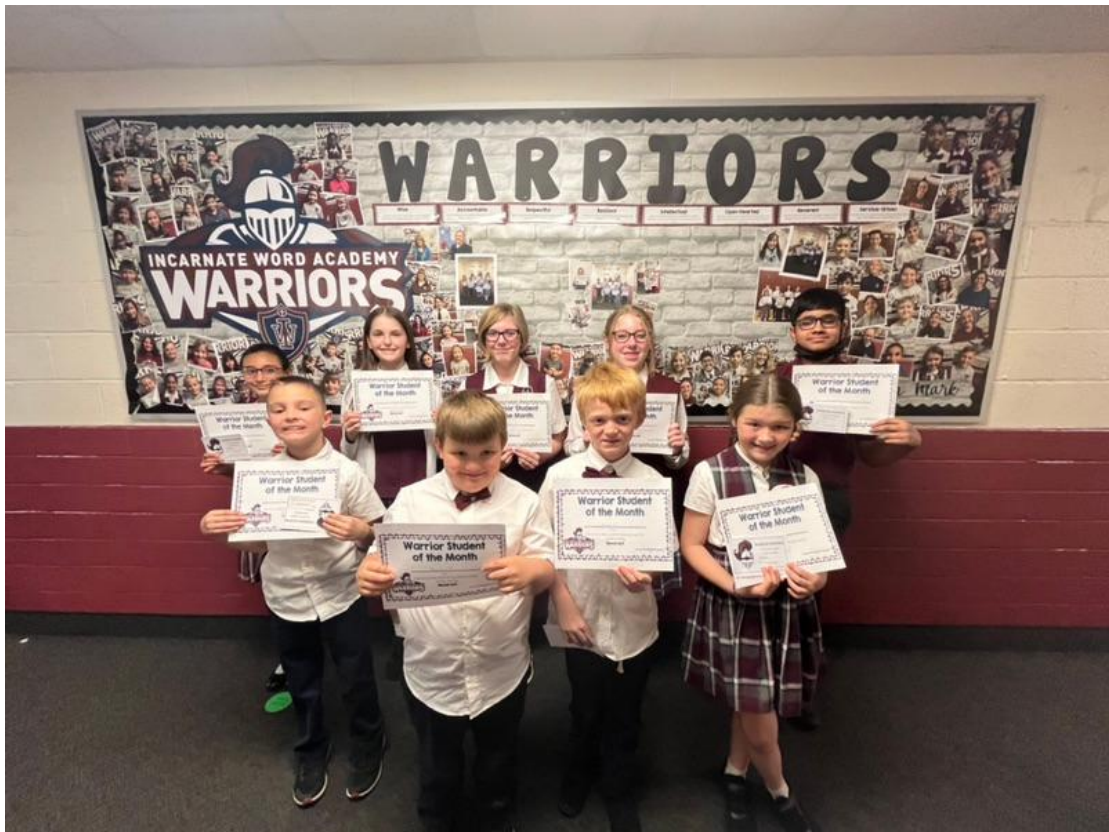

Practices will be three weeknights per week from late July to

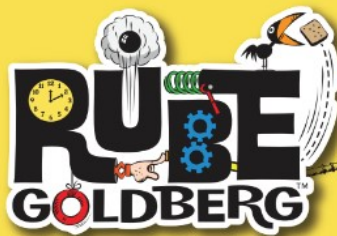
