

4th Grade Summer Reading Project



Directions: Each student will need to read one of the listed books and create a paper bag project. It must include the following:

Front of the Bag:

- Include the title of the book, the author, a neatly colored illustration that represents the story, and **your** name at the bottom of the bag.
- The illustration on the front of your bag should be drawn and colored by hand; **no computer help!** Your drawings should be colorful, detailed, and neatly completed.

Back of the Bag:

- The back of your bag should contain a summary of your book.
- Your summary should be written in five to eight sentences. Be sure to include the most important information from your book!
- Write your summary in your own words and in complete sentences. Remember to edit your work.
- Under your summary, write your favorite quote from the book. Remember to put your quote inside quotation marks!

Inside the Bag:

- Inside your bag, you should include **five items** that represent the theme and/or the story elements (characters, settings, problem, and solution) of your book.
- You may only include two drawings/pictures as part of the five items.
- The size of your bag will be determined by the items you select for your project.
