Annual Trireme Race Causes a Splash









Our preparatory enrichment course, Ancient Greek Triremes, headed to Cleveland State University today to put student designs to the test. After months of designing and testing prototypes, the students constructed triremes that could hold as much as possible before capsizing or sinking. Students discovered the historical significance of triremes, mathematically analyzed their designs, and learned a little Ancient Greek in the process!

This week they visited the IWA Innovation Center, collaborating and learning with community partners from the Upcycle Parts Shop in Cleveland.
