

### **Sixth Grade Noun Gallery Walk**

This past Monday, sixth grade grammarians took part in their first Grammar Gallery Walk of the year.

Each month Ms. Shalala does a "deep dive" into one of the eight parts of speech, beginning with nouns. Students take in-class notes, complete exercises, watch grammar videos, and review independently. At the end of each month, the culminating activity on that focused part of speech is a group grammar Gallery Walk.

This type of collaborative assessment allows students to be actively engaged as they walk throughout the preparatory hallway and investigate grammar. They work together with a partner or in small groups to share ideas and respond to quiz questions. Though they are talking through each problem together, they are all submitting their own answer key for an independent grade.



# STOP THE HATE


