

PARENT EDUCATION FREEDOM ACT

At a recent town hall hosted at Holy Name High School, State Senator Sandra O'Brien outlined her proposal for Universal EdChoice Scholarship through SB11, the Parent Education Freedom Act.

She noted that the newly expanded EdChoice Scholarship would provide \$5,500 for every student in grades K-8 and \$7,500 for every student in grades 9-12. The scholarships can be used at any chartered non-public school, including Catholic schools, in the State of Ohio. While she is confident that the bill will pass in the Senate, she is uncertain that it will make it through the House of Representatives.




