ETYMOLOGY IN PRIMARY

Pathology, pathogen, and sympathetic. Just some of the works that our students in first grade explored today in Mr. Halusker's Etymology course. The students discussed the meaning and spelling of words with the root *path*. They were asked to provide the definitions of *path*, *patho*, and *pathy*. Responses generated were feeling words, diseases, suffering, and disorders. Yes, they are in first grade!



Towards the end of the class, student teams were challenged to generate words from *vers* and *vert*, sharing their responses by creating digital post-its of their words on the Clevertouch.

In addition to teaching Etymology, World Cultures, and Latin, Mr. Halusker shares his passion for collecting and caring for cacti with his students.

KINDERGARTEN SCREENING

Screening for Kindergarten will take place on Monday, March 10 and Tuesday, March 11 in St. Joseph Hall. If you have a child who does not currently attend IWA that you would like to enroll in Kindergarten for the 2025-26 school year be sure to sign up for a time slot using the link below. Families with a child who is currently enrolled in



our Kinder Prep program do <u>not</u> need to sign up for a time slot.

Areas of assessment are Physical Development, Language Development, Academic Skills/Cognitive Development, and Self-Help and Social-Emotional Skills. The purpose of the screening is to determine strengths, opportunities for growth, and to provide you with some activities that you can do with your child over the summer to help him/her be ready for kindergarten in August. The screening will take approximately 45 minutes to complete and we ask that a family member remain at St. Joseph Hall while screening is conducted.

KINDER PREP ENROLLMENT

We are excited to announce that enrollment for our Kinder Prep program is now open! This is a wonderful opportunity to begin your child's educational journey at Incarnate Word Academy.

Please note that your child must be **4 years old** to begin the program and a **non-refundable \$250 registration fee and 10% of tuition are required** at the time of enrollment to reserve your child's place.

ATTENDANCE REMINDER

This is a friendly reminder from page 8 of the Parent Student Handbook:

If a student is absent, his or her parent/guardian must call the Attendance Office at 440- 842- 6818 Ext. 305 to report the absence or complete the Attendance Form on our IWA App.

Parents may email the Attendance Office, **please do not email the teacher**. If the Attendance Office does not receive a call, parents will be contacted at home or work. In the event no one is available in the Attendance Office a message may be left on voicemail. Please give the following information when calling: name of student, homeroom number or teacher, reason for absence, and your name with a phone number where you can be reached. Upon return to school after an absence of 1 to 3 days, a written excuse given to the homeroom teacher stating the reason for the absence, and signed by the parent/guardian is necessary. After 3 days a doctor's note is required.
