2025-2026 TUITION INVOICES

Last week all families were billed for the 2025-2026 tuition based on the personal tuition statement from Mr. Wisnor sent home in January 2025 with enrollment information. This invoice is due by May 30, 2025. After this date, a \$200.00 surcharge per child will be added to your account. All tuition is to be paid in full by August 1, 2025. When you log into Digital Academy you will see a remaining balance for 2024-2025 tuition on your account. DO NOT PAY THIS. This is the balance of your award from the state that is paid each month. This balance will not be paid in full until June of this



year. Again, do not pay this invoice. Please only select to make your payment on the description that reads 2025-2026 tuition. If you have any questions please contact Mrs. Bleakley before making any payments: hbleakley@incarnatewordacademy.org.

Should you prefer to take a loan for your 2025-2026 tuition invoice you may apply

for an IWA Tuition Loan through <u>Unity Catholic Federal Credit Union</u>.

- 1. Go to Unity Catholic's website by clickingHERE.
- 2. In the upper right corner, click "Apply For A Loan"
- 3. Select "IWA Tuition Loan"
- 4. Select "Individual Credit"
- 5. Someone from Unity Catholic will contact you to complete this process.

We ask that you sign off on the final loan documents by May 16.

KINDER PREP ENROLLMENT

Enrollment for our Kinder Prep program is open! This is a wonderful opportunity to begin your child's educational journey at Incarnate Word Academy.

Please note that your child must be 4 years old to begin the program and a nonrefundable \$250 registration fee and 10% of tuition are required at the time of enrollment to reserve your child's place.
