


Congratulations to our Warrior students and teacher that were recognized for being WISE during the month of September.

Faculty Awarded Governor's Award for STEM for the 18th Consecutive Year



IWA is proud to announce that we have received the Governor's Award for STEM for the 18th consecutive year! The Ohio Academy of Science awarded the *ENTIRE IWA FACULTY* the Thomas Edison Award for Excellence in STEM Education. First established in 1985, this award was initiated to recognize schools and teachers for excellence in STEM education and scientific student research.

As defined by the Ohio Academy of Science, STEM education "incorporates scientific inquiry and technological design through student-focused, project-based curricula to develop skills of communication, teamwork/collaboration, creativity/innovation, critical thinking, and problem solving."

This year's award recognizes 1,244 teachers from 76 schools across the State of Ohio who stimulate research and design and develop experiential opportunities beyond traditional classroom activities.

"We are proud to honor these schools and teachers for preparing students for the future, " says Michael E. Woytek, the Ohio Academy of Science's Director. "Science is a critical driver of economical growth by fostering innovation, creating new industries, and generating high-skilled jobs."

NOT be spray painted and weapons or weapon-like accessories are not allowed.










