

FUTURE ENGINEERS, APPLES REIMAGINED










Kindergarten students put their creativity to work in the Innovation Center during the LEGO Apple Challenge! Building on their recent studies regarding apples, students used LEGO blocks to design their own apple creations while exploring shapes, spatial reasoning, and problem-solving. This fun, hands-on activity strengthened fine motor skills and encouraged students to share and describe their unique designs.



Thank you to all of the families that supported the chili cook off today at Saint Joseph Hall. All proceeds collected will be given to Mia's family.











## **SKI CLUB SIGN-UPS**


