

OUR DIVERSITY IS AN EXPRESSION OF GOD'S CREATIVITY







Our amazing faculty and admin team spent Friday engaging in a variety of ways that continue to support both our students and our spiritual and academic needs.

Our Preparatory team, members from our Specials level, and Mrs. Hribar participated in everything AI with presenter *Dan Humphrey, Director of Information Technology at St. Edward High School*. This learning focused on ways to embrace AI in the classroom, ethical considerations, and overall AI literacy so that students learn how to use AI to enhance learning, rather than to replace learning. This year, Incarnate Word Academy was the recipient of an Ohio TechCred grant, which provided funding to purchase Khanmigo, a teacher and student program acts as one's personalized learning coach.



There's still time to RSVP! All Alumni and their families are welcome to join us this Sunday for Mass with brunch and Mimosas to follow in the Sisters Dining Room.






MIA'S FIGHT, OUR FIGHT
